### **HURRICANE SEASON-JUNE 1-ARE YOU PREPARED?**

The Hurricane season starts Wednesday, June 1st and while the past couple of years it has been fairly quiet and we hope it stays that way, here are a few reminders. Above all, keep safe.

- 1. Evacuation of the community is mandatory in case of a hurricane. Please notify the office as to where you are going when leaving; i.e. shelter, hotel, a friends', or relatives. We need to know how to reach you after the event is over, so this year we will be passing a form to fill out and return.
- 2. Make your plans in advance. Contact the shelter best suited for you and check out the facilities. Pack a TO GO Bag a least three days worth of medicine, bedding, food, drinks, water, reading material, games, and toilet paper.
- 3. The Rec Center is not a Hurricane Shelter. The closest shelter is Hilltop Elementary, directly across US 17 from the entrance on Maxwell. Phone is 773-2750
- 3. The Special Needs Shelter is South Florida Community College, 1 mile north on US 17.on the right. Phone is 773-3081
- Shelter space is limited, so call ahead and make arrangements at the shelter of your choice.
